History

Site is Phase 2 of a 1000+ acre industrial district that contains a combination of transportation, manufacturing, chemical, office, and heavy industrial users.



Rail Connection

Alabama Gulf Coast Railroad (AGRR) rail siding, a Genessee Wyoming company, connects to 5 Class 1 railroads (and 11 railroads total).



Port Connection

20 minute drive-time to Port of Mobile, the Gulf Coast's fastest growing container port.

50 miles to Port of Pascagoula and 79 miles to Port of Pensacola, 2 growing general cargo port districts.



Interstate Connection

2 miles to I-65, connecting Mobile, AL to Chicago, IL

20 miles to I-10, connecting Los Angeles, CA to Jacksonville, FL

309 miles to Atlanta, GA



Airport Connection

20 minute drive-time to a new, modern multi-modal cargo and passenger transportation hub scheduled to begin operations in 2025: Mobile International Airport.

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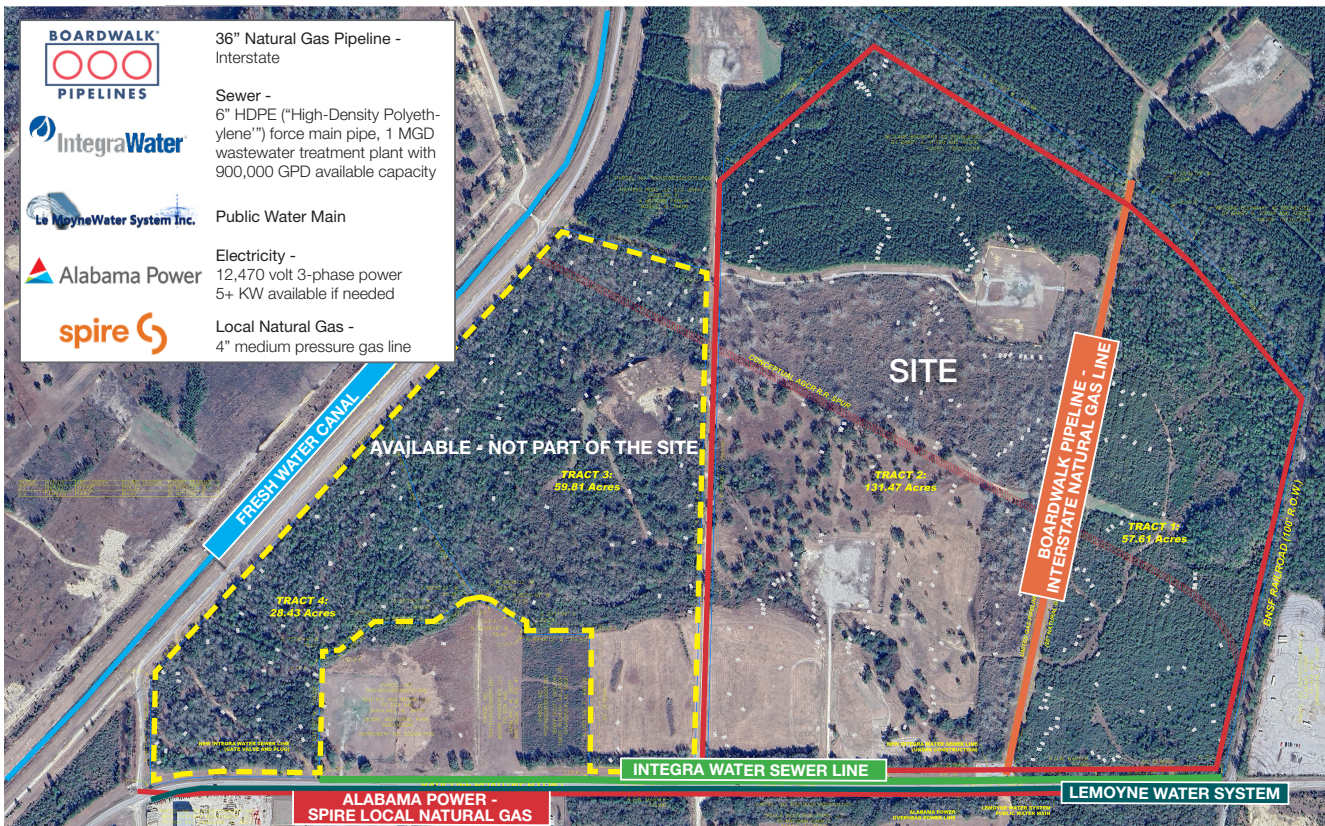
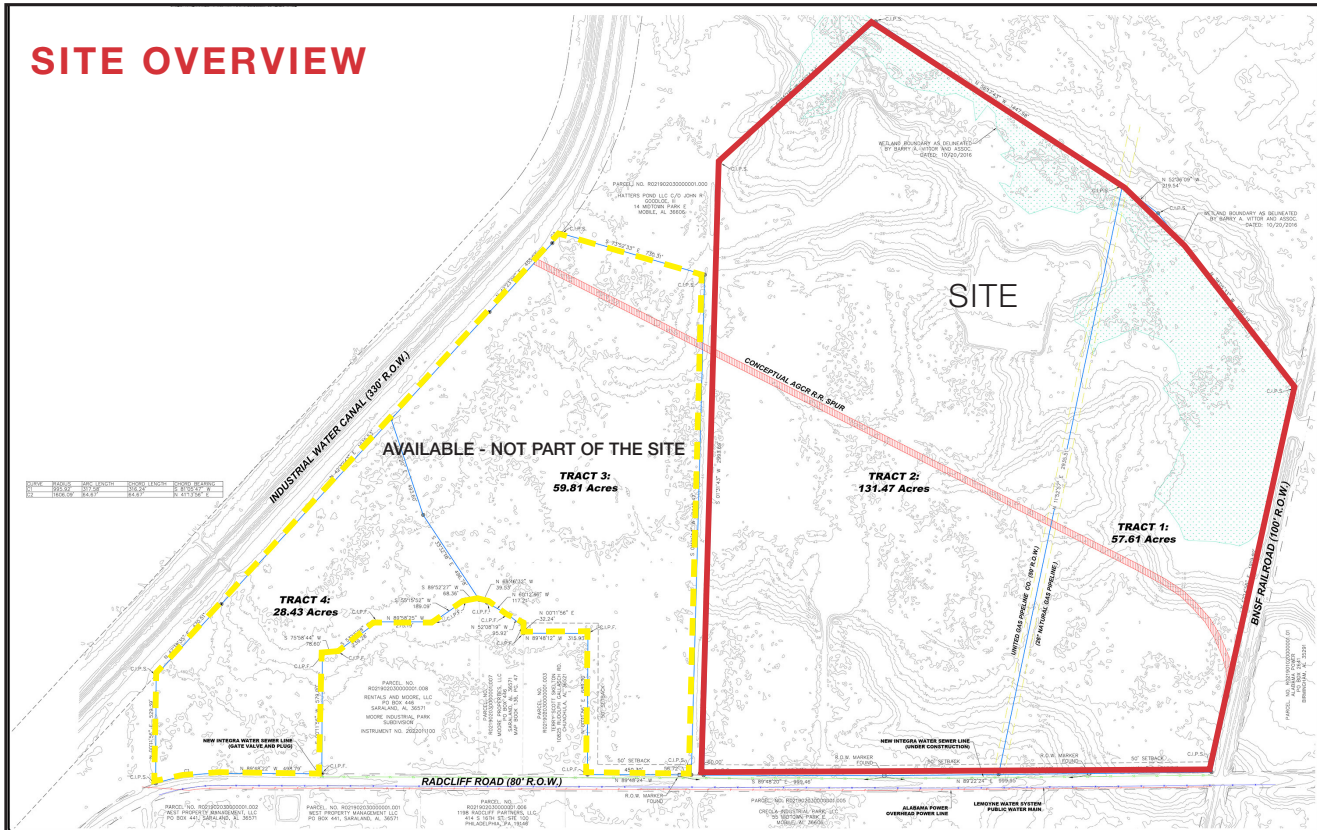
EXAMPLE SITE PLAN 1



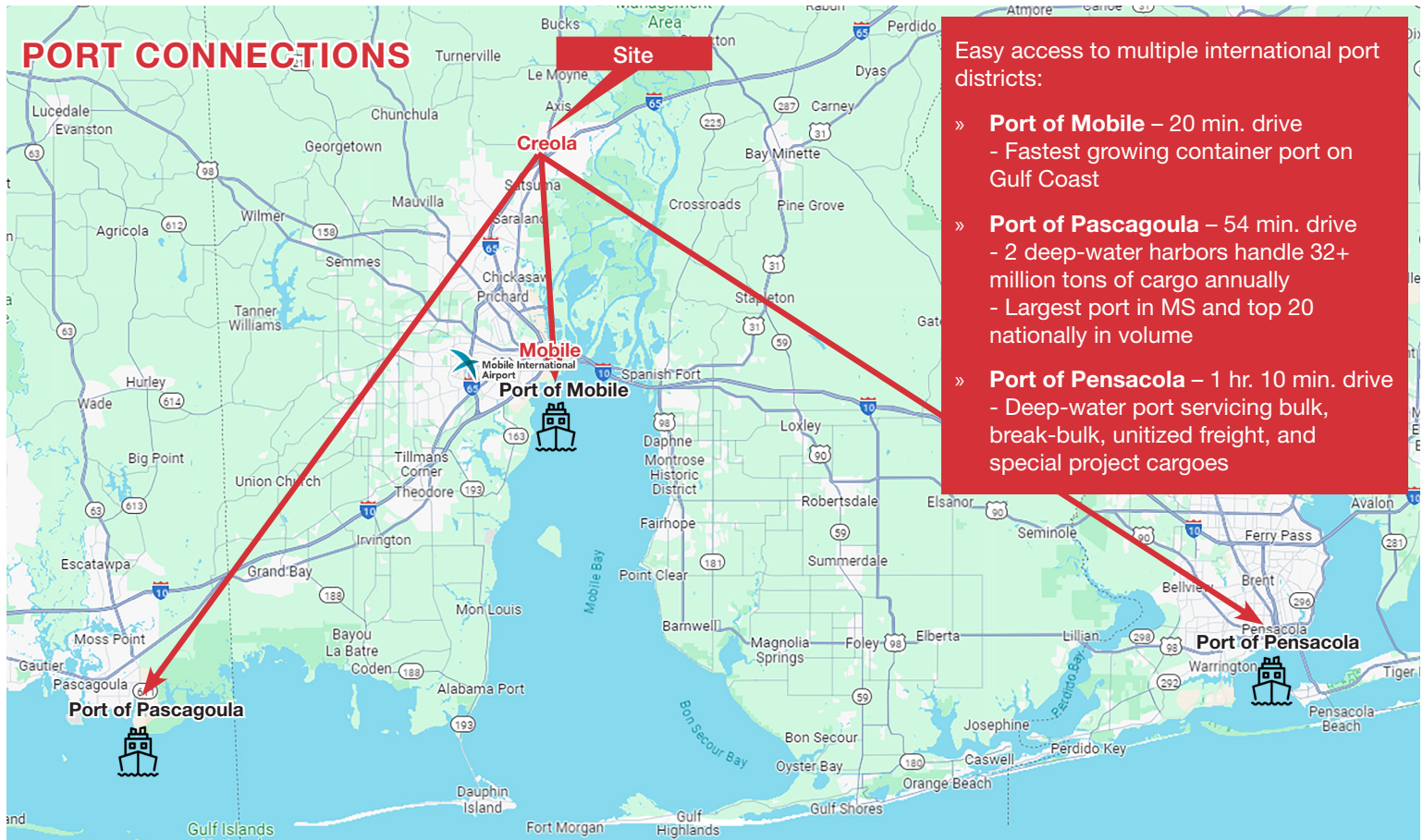
EXAMPLE SITE PLAN 2
